Every Christian is a missionary to the extent that he or she has encountered the love of God in Christ Jesus: we no longer say that we are “disciples” and “missionaries”, but rather that we are always “missionary disciples”. If we are not convinced, let us look at those first disciples, who, immediately after encountering the gaze of Jesus, went forth to proclaim him joyfully: “We have found the Messiah!”

In this joyful Easter season, let us look at Mary Magdalene who in the Resurrection’s garden received from Jesus the task of bringing the news of the Resurrection to the disciples.

Gospel of Jesus Christ according to Saint John, Jn 20, 11-18

Now Mary stood outside the tomb crying. As she wept, she bent over to look into the tomb and saw two angels in white, seated where Jesus’ body had been, one at the head and the other at the foot. They asked her, “Woman, why are you crying?” “They have taken my Lord away,” she said, “and I don’t know where they have put him.” At this, she turned around and saw Jesus standing there, but she did not realize that it was Jesus.

He asked her, “Woman, why are you crying? Who is it you are looking for?”

Thinking he was the gardener, she said, “Sir, if you have carried him away, tell me where you have put him, and I will get him.” Jesus said to her, “Mary.” She turned toward him and cried out in Aramaic, “Rabboni!” (which means “Teacher”). Jesus said, “Do not hold on to me, for I have not yet ascended to the Father. Go instead to my brothers and tell them, ‘I am ascending to my Father and your Father, to my God and your God.’” Mary Magdalene went to the disciples with the news: “I have seen the Lord!” And she told them that he had said these things to her.

Our falling short of perfection should be no excuse; on the contrary, mission is a constant stimulus not to remain mired in mediocrity but to continue growing.

Let us listen deep down in our heart to the words of some missionary-disciples who are close to us: Jeanne Antide, Agostina, Nemesia, Enrichetta ... with their lives they have given us hope.

Refrain: We praise You, we bless You, and we thank You, o Lord!

Saint Jeanne Antide wrote: «Also the Sisters of Charity have received the Spirit of God ... therefore, they can go all over the earth and also the sea. When God calls and we listen to Him, He gives all that is needed» *refrain*

Sr Agostina wrote: «I feel inflamed with charity towards everybody and ready to face any sacrifice, even to spread my blood for charity, if it is the will of God» *refrain*

Sr Nemesia wrote: «It is nice to be heroes, yet it is better to be good ... good to everyone, to those suffering and to those who make us suffer. Goodness towards the prisoners, goodness to all. Everybody suffers and we should share the suffering of all» *refrain*

Sr Enrichetta wrote: «Lord ... I carry in my own the hearts of all people: I offer them to you so that You may convert them and they may praise you ... How would I like to give a language and a heart to all creatures to this purpose ...» *refrain*
